Stages of Emergency Management

- Prevention
- Preparedness
- Response
- Recovery

Prevention

- Action to avoid an incident or stop it from occurring
 - Examples
 - What hazards or emergencies can you foresee or have you had on your campus?

Preparedness

- Goal is to reduce impact
 - What steps need to be taken to be ready
 - Emergency staffing and communications plan
 - Training
 - Identify resources and supplies / mutual aid
 - Designating facilities

Response

- Once the event happens...
 - Implement the plan
 - Situation assessment
 - Prioritize

Recovery


- After the incident is over...
 - Business continuity
 - Communication and resources
 - After-action review
